¹ Payout for this tournament will be one-half of all entry fees. *Scalable* means that payout is based on entry. Payout could be \$3 million, given sufficient entry. OTOH payout might be a considerably smaller amount.

Scoring and Payout

This tournament will be a sweepstakes. Half of all entry fees will be paid back to owner/handlers of top performing dogs on this basis:

Each game/event ~ top 5 placements

Entire tournament ~ top 10 placements

Placements are based on Performance Points which is inverse to the number of dogs in a class. For example, if 100 dogs are playing, then the first-place dog will earn 100 points, and the last-place dog 1 point.

A dog's Tournament score will be a sum of all LPP earned in each game/event.

Game/Event Payout will be made at the end of each day. Tournament payout will be made at end of day Sunday.

Site will be open at 7:00 AM for set up. Obstacle Familiarization at 7:30 AM. Judging will start at 8:30 AM.

This trial will be held indoors on dog sport matting.

PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG AT THE SHOW SITE.

All dogs must be kept on leash except in designated areas.

Volunteers are the backbone of any agility trial. We need all hands to make this invitational tournament work. Please volunteer to work at every opportunity. We reserve the right to refuse entry to exhibitors who don't tend to volunteer.

Eligibility – This trial is open to all dogs, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

Your dog must be registered with the NDAL to participate. There is a registration form included in this premium, or you can register the day of the tournament.

CLASS INFORMATION

Numbered Course ~ The common version of the game consisting of a logical sequence of obstacles: jumps, tunnels, contact obstacles, and perhaps the weave poles. A numbered course is scored Time, Plus Faults.

Looper ~ A simple sequencing game in which the dog is directed to perform a numbered sequence of obstacles twice. Looper is scored Time, Plus Faults.

Time Warp ~ A numbered sequence that features one or more distance challenges for which Time Warp bonuses can be earned. It is possible to have negative score! Time Warp is scored Time, Plus Faults, Less Bonus.

Call, Direct and Send ~ A numbered course that presents three distance challenges: Call, Direct, and Send. CDS is scored Time, Plus Faults, Less Bonus.

Pole Jacks ~ A game of strategy and skill, played like the children's game of jacks. The performance of a short set of weave poles is the bounce of the ball. All other obstacles on the course are jacks and have specific point values. After the bounce the team begins with "onsies" then "twosies"... and all the way through "sevensies", time permitting. Pole Jacks is scored Points, then time.

Time Warp Looper ~ A numbered sequence that is performed twice AND features one or more distance challenges for which bonuses can be earned. A Time Warp Looper is scored Time, Plus Faults, Less Bonus.

Mulligans Rule
