



# AKC AGILITY COURSE TEST ACT LEVELS 1 & 2

Check-in will begin at least 30 minutes after the regular agility trial ends but not before noon. Dogs must be on lead or securely crated when not in the ring.

Fees: \$10/run pre-entry (by March 4), Day of Show entries \$15 1<sup>st</sup> run, \$10/run additional runs (includes \$5 AKC recording fee). Entry Limit: 60 runs.

Running order: ACT 1 Round 1, ACT 1 Round 2, ACT 2 Round 1, ACT 2 Round 2. Green flat qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all qualifiers along with a dog toy.

The Agility Course Test (ACT) is an entry-level agility event designed to introduce beginning dogs and their handlers to the sport of agility. Any dog that has not earned an AKC agility title is eligible and you can run in one or both levels at the same event. You do not have to complete ACT 1 before entering ACT 2, however, if the dog earns the ACT 2 title, it cannot go back and get the ACT 1. 2 qualifying legs are required to earn a title.

If someone gets their ACT 1 title after completing one run, we can accommodate changing their second entry to ACT 2. If A Novice title is earned in the morning, they are not eligible to run in the ACT event in the afternoon.

The money will be refunded.

ACT Level 1 will have 10-12 obstacles: 5' aframe, table, tunnels, and jumps (no spread jumps); tire & panel jumps are allowed but not required.

ACT Level 2 courses have 11-13 obstacles, including all of the obstacles allowed in Level 1 plus the teeter, 6 weaves, tire, and 1 spread jump (triple, double, or broad); the dogwalk is allowed but not required.

Refusals & Run-outs are not judged. More than 3 attempts at an obstacle will result in an elimination. The rest of the faults are the same as in the regular agility classes. All passing scores can be under the same judge. Only one dog in the ring at a time.

Dogs may be entered at any of the following jump heights: 4, 8, 12, 16, 20 or 24 inches, handler's choice. A jump height card is not required. Dogs will not be measured.

Dogs must be 15 months or older and meet the requirements for a regular AKC agility trial (Chapter 1, Section 3), except that they do not need to be registered with AKC.

Dogs that are not AKC registered may participate and their performance will be recorded by the AKC under a temporary recording number. This temporary number will be emailed to the owner and must be used when entering subsequent ACT events; it may not be used for other AKC events.

INSTRUCTIONS

Dogs may be entered in any jump height. There is no Regular or Preferred distinction at AKC's ACT events.

In order to acquire the ACT1 or ACT2 title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered/listed with the American Kennel Club. AKC Canine PartnersSM applications may be accepted at the event and submitted to AKC with the event's results.

Dogs that are not AKC registered/listed may be registered at a later date and receive their ACT title at that time.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
